All the teachers I work with directly use the same Youtube (Google) account to store and share videos. Students can then subscribe to the individual courses and teachers can colate videos together.

These videos might be:

- 1. Recorded by their iPads
- 2. Recorded by Student iPads
- 3. Explain Everything (App) whiteboard lessons
- 1. Video tutorials for practical tasks
- 5. Youtube videos discovered on Youtube itself and added to course "Playlists"

Here's an intro into how we use and manage our Youtube account.

Step 1: Sign up to Google as a department or school.

Step 2: Visit Youtube and login with Google account to activate the Youtube account.


Playlisting a video

Using the Video Manager mentioned on Page 1, you can Playlist multiply videos recently uploaded by ticking them and choosing a playlist.





What's Unlisted?

To keep things simple I tell my staff to always use **Unlisted** unless the video involves a student's face. Unlisted means that the video is not discoverable when searching Youtube but you can use the video's web address in your school's LMS or on Worksheets to send students & parents directly to the video.






Enhancements and Annotations When you are on the website and viewing the settings for one of your uploads

Sharing

Under any **video** or entire **playlist**, the "Share" option gives you the web address you can give to students etc.

Embed gives you the HTML code to paste into your School's LMS or Website. All videos in a playlist will then play from within your website, LMS or Blog.
